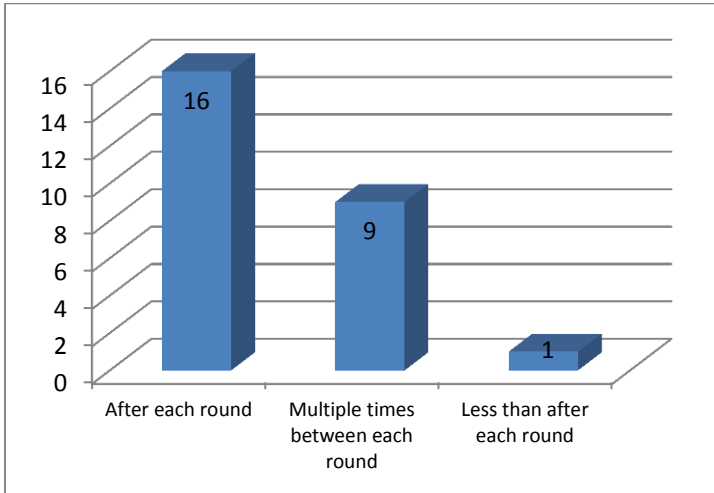


## 2013 Player Survey Results (26 Responses Received)

### Website:

25 players thought the website was easy to use, with most looking to use after each round.



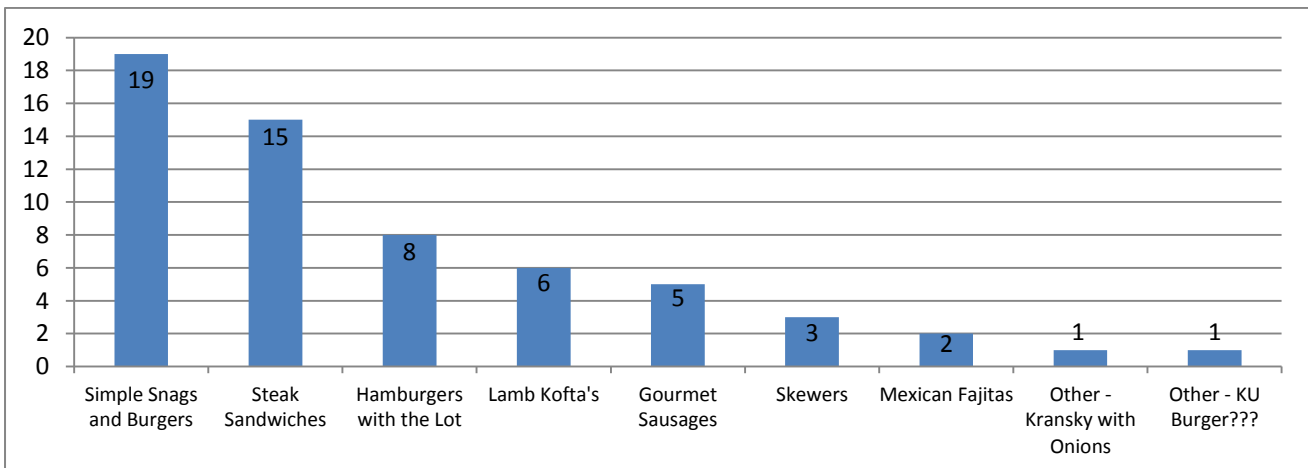
Some suggestions for what else to include on the website are below, and will be looked into as we develop the site further over the coming months:

The club had a name change in 1985/6 from TAA Tee-Jets (T-Jet was the marketing name for TAA's "new" 727 jet engined aircraft way back when) to the Australian Airlines Golf Club (TAA changed names!). All 26 players love a BBQ, with 21 voting the frequency was "Just Right", and 4 voting "Not Often Enough"

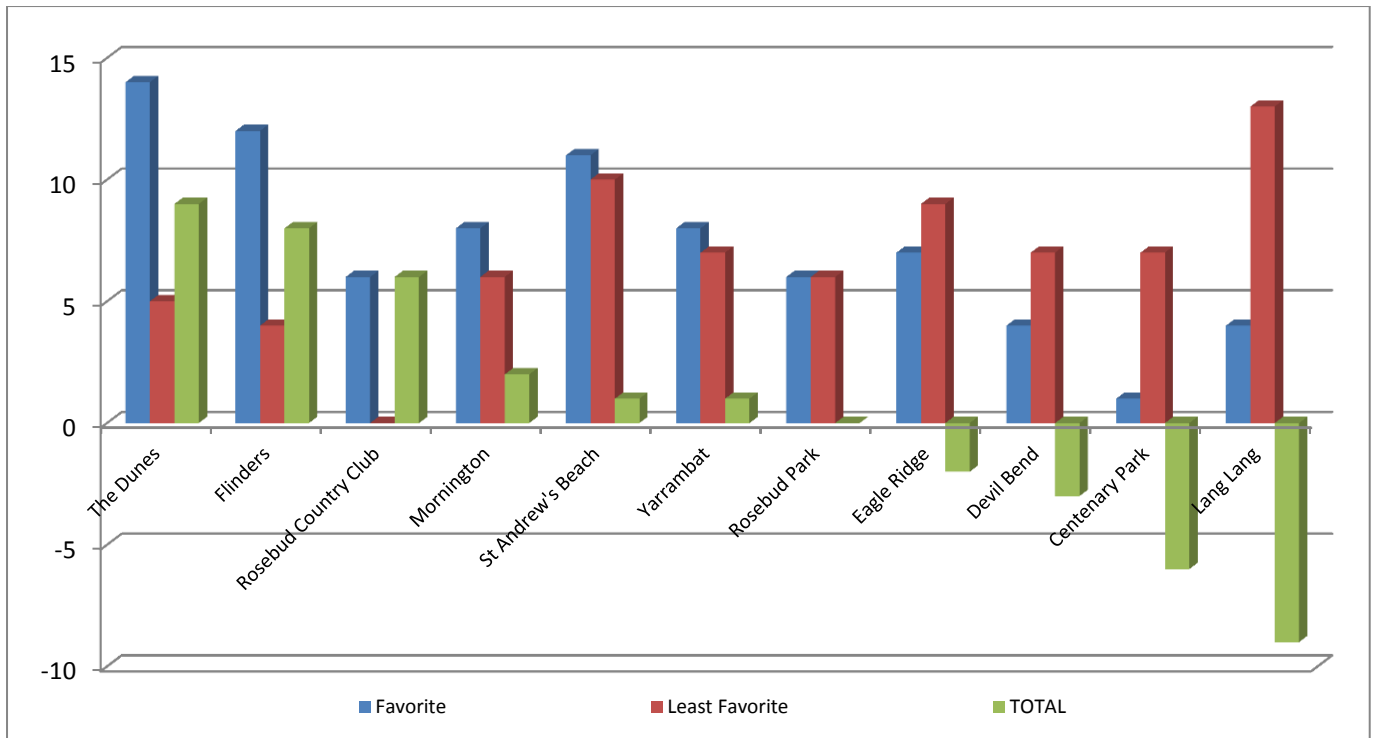
The preferred food options were below, will take these into account for the future:



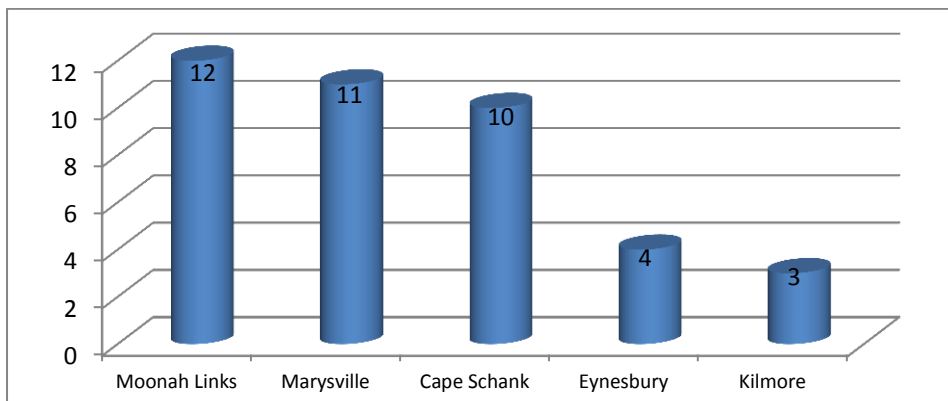
## Golf Courses:

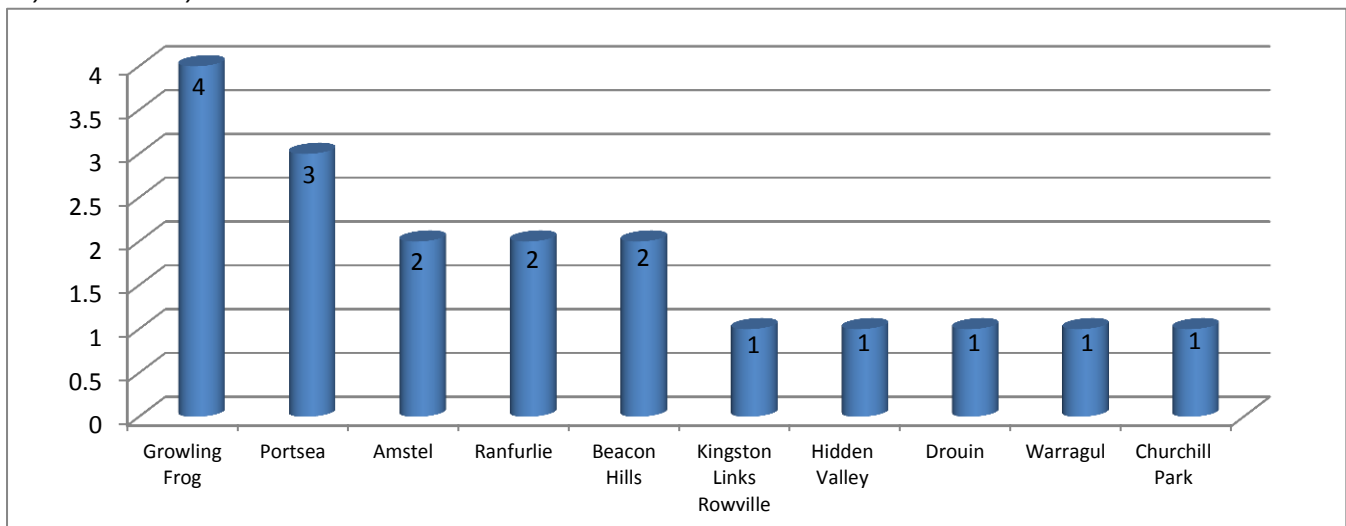
### Favorite and Least Favorite Courses:



### Back on the Fixture:

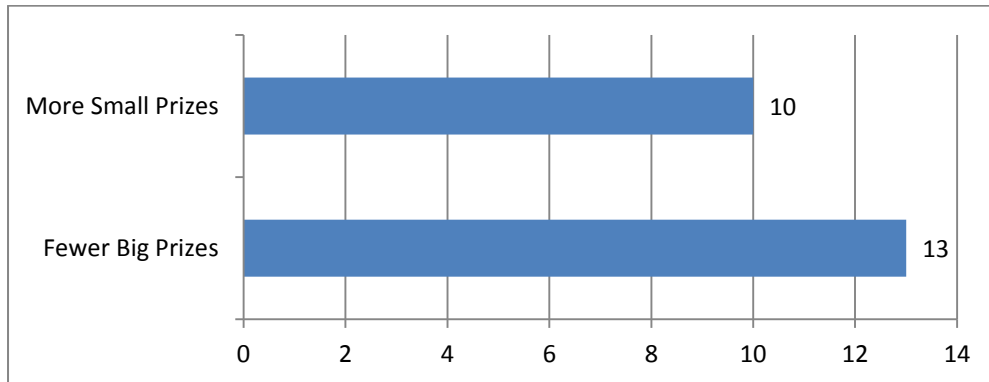

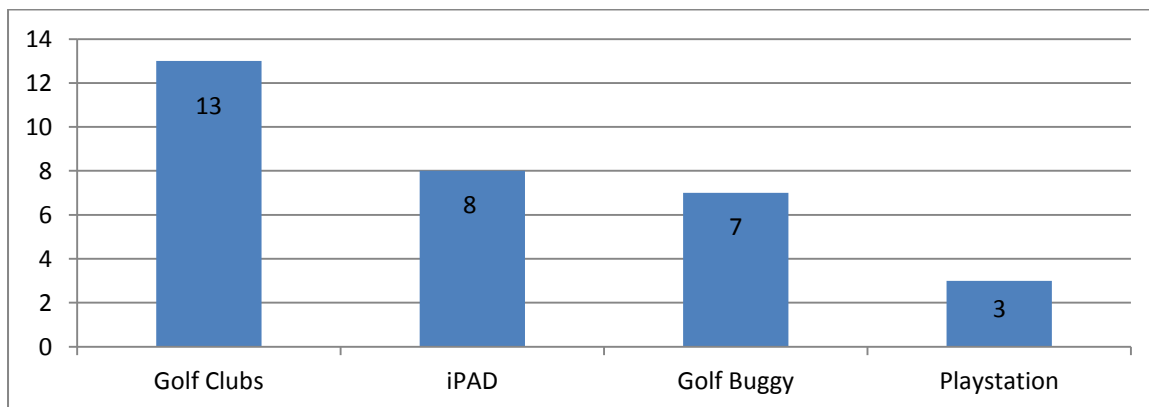

## Xmas Raffle

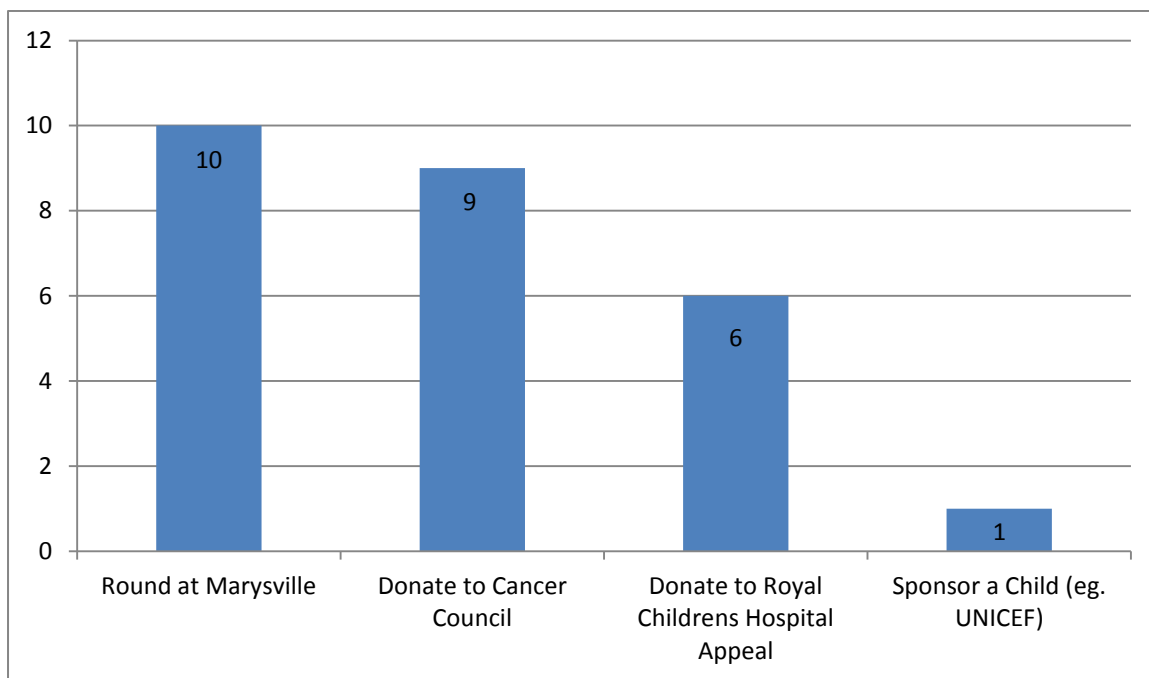
23 players like the Xmas Raffle. Preferred major prize votes were:
