FRED Vs SIR BOB CRAZY CHALLENGE:

As Fred and Sir Bob have been known to do, another CRAZY challenge has been thrown on the table by the two antagonists. This time Fred may actually be killed in the process.

The challenge is for both Fred and Sir Bob to walk the Flinders Course whilst consuming 12 beers (min) during the days play. The rules are as follows:

- Fred and Sir Bob are competing in a Matchplay competition challenge.
- The loser pays the club \$100.00
- In the case of a draw, a countback will be conducted (ie there will be no draw)
- Fred will play of a handicap of 42, whilst Bob will play of a handicap of 25, being a difference of 17 for the age difference between the two parties.
- Both parties must walk the complete course
- Both parties must consume (minimum) the following beers by the hole number
 - o 1st beer prior to start
 - o 2nd beer by the end of 1st Hole
 - o 3rd by end of 3rd Hole
 - o 4th by end of 5th Hole
 - o 5th by end of 6th Hole
 - o 6th by end of 8th Hole
 - o 7th by end of 9th Hole
 - o 8th by end of 10th Hole
 - o 9th by end of 12th Hole
 - 10th by end of 14th Hole
 - 11th by end of 16th Hole
 - 12th by end of 18th Hole
- 24 Beers will be supplied by the club out of the \$100.00 winnings.
- Drinking can not start until both Fred and Sir Bob are at the Course and both agree that the challenge has commenced (I'm giving you an out here Fred).
- There is no restriction on how quick the beers can be drunk (ie you can drink all 12 beers by the 5th hole if you want), however there is a minimum number of beers that must be drunk by certain holes, unless both parties agree to change.
- Failure to drink the required number of beers by the due hole will result in a forfeit of the entire Matchplay.
- Gary Kelly and one other (possibly Me) will accompany Fred and Bob in the group, and will have a cart for the Beer Supplies and to act as an Emergency Vehicle.
- If either Fred or Bob ride in the cart then they forfeited the entire Match Play.

- Gary will have his mobile phone with 000 entered. The call button will be made the moment Fred someone collapses.
- Sir Bob is not responsible for Fred's death
